TRT Minutes
September 12, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Captain Michele Cyr at 12:15pm.

Old business:

Kurt Ballantyne brought to our attention Article 10, section 221.4 of the Ft. Lupton Municipal Code about guns which allow "ceremonial" salutes. The article says "Representatives of service, fraternal or educational organizations firing blank cartridges at ceremonial occasions of the nature of funeral rites, parades, or starting guns at formal athletic meets and rehearsal for such occasions and similar events".

Kurt motioned that 2 ceremonial salutes are allowed at a rendezvous, one each day to be determined by the booshway. Joe Page seconded the motion. It was reiterated that TRT has no insurance coverage to support these salutes but the risk would be minimal. Motion passed.

Scribe Jan Clower read the minutes from the August 16, 2009 meeting. There was one minor correction. The correction stated that Boy Scouts were planning a camporee to be held Sept. 25, 2009. Kurt Ballantyne motioned that the August minutes be corrected and Gina Patterson seconded. The minutes were approved.

TRT Purser report by Nancy Dawdy-

Nancy reported that the TRT checking account was about \$788.00. She had \$250.00 to deposit yet and there would still be deposits made from the three remaining rendezvous. Gina Patterson motioned to accept the purser report and Ben Haskew seconded. The report was approved.

The tractor was repaired, the power steering problem was covered under warranty.

Michele reported that regarding the TRT X-mas party, she had not contacted the contra band further due to the TRT treasury balance, but she would inquire further.

The handicapped hooter has been repaired.

Kurt Ballantyne motioned to spend up to \$200.00 to purchase 2x4's for hooter enclosures to match the enclosures which have been finished. Nancy Dawdy seconded the motion and the motion passed.

There was a correction to prior minutes to say that "black powder is allowed in camp but no one can fire black powder."

The camp rules were amended to say instead of "no cursing or swearing in camp" to "no unreasonable cursing or swearing." No other camp rules were changed at this time.

There is no work party for September.

The next TRT meeting will be held on October 10th before the potluck at the Hot Iron Rendezvous.
